



Angela Merici was born in the late 15th century in a small village in northern Italy. Angela founded the Company of Saint Ursula, a group of women living a life of consecrated virginity "in the world." Her followers did not live in convents, but rather lived and worked out in the community, among the people. They did not have a specific ministry but were to respond to the needs of their times. Leading a holy life was their focus. She was a reconciler and business woman, and urged others to be like a "piazza" (a place of openness and welcome). She was canonized a saint in 1807.
