

She reflected: "The roads of Juárez are very deserted these days it is very hot and there are strong winds on some days. Here in Juárez there are 24 shelters that are run by our Christian brothers. Only four shelters are Catholic, which means that there are not many Catholic volunteers. The good news is that there is only one God who collaborates with God's plan to give bread to the hungry and a place where each migrant who arrives in Juárez can rest."

On May 7, the actual day of the Kentucky Derby, several of the Louisville Ursulines got together




